**Value-added Product Change:**

The Sonic System (old ID#: SA-SS1200C) now has 2 receivers for the same price of \$189.95. The additional item now included in the system is the SA-BL300 (Sonic Blink), increasing alerting to four rooms. New ID#: SA-SS1200C/B.
